WHAT IS HEPATITIS A INFECTION?


A contagious liver disease resulting from infection with the Hepatitis A virus


WHAT ARE THE SYMPTOMS?

- Fever
- Fatigue
- Vomiting
- Loss of appetite
- Nausea
- Jaundice (yellow color in the eyes or skin)
- Grey colored stools
- Dark urine
- Abdominal pain
- Joint pain

HOW IS IT SPREAD?

- Consuming food or drinks that are contaminated with the feces of an infected individual
- Having close contact with diapers or fecal material from an infected person

HOW CAN I PREVENT INFECTION?

- Get vaccinated: 2 shots, 6 months apart.
- Wash hands with soap and water after using the bathroom, after changing a diaper and before preparing or eating food.
- Only drink <u>chlorinated</u> water
- Avoid eating raw oysters
- Use condoms if engaging in sexual activities
