Home visits and clinical evaluations required. Participates in Team meetings and the Primary Service Provider model.

MINIMUM QUALIFICATIONS: Doctorate or Master's degree in speech-language pathology or audiology, or both, from an accredited college or university **AND** current Georgia licensure and/or certification to practice in area of assignment.
