

COVID-19 Epidemiology Report for DeKalb County January 25, 2021

- As of January 24, DeKalb County has reported 44,735 confirmed cases of 2019 novel coronavirus disease (COVID-19) and 567 confirmed COVID-19 deaths. An increase of 1,656 cases (+3.8%) and 17 deaths (+3.1%) since the last report on January 20.
- 5,169 COVID-19 cases (652 cases per 100,000 population) were diagnosed in the most recent 14 day period (1/5 1/18), a **12.0% INCREASE** from the previous 14 day period (12/22 1/4).
- Among all persons diagnosed with COVID-19 in DeKalb County, 8.0% needed hospitalization and 1.3% died.
- As of January 25, Georgia Department of Public Health reported that DeKalb County accounted for 6.2% of total number of COVID-19 cases in Georgia to date.












COVID-19 Testing and Positivity in DeKalb County


COVID-19 Related Deaths in DeKalb County and Georgia








^{*}In order to account for reporting lag of new diagnoses, the 14 day periods were calculated from a week prior. Data cleaning may lead to reassignment of cases from one territory to another based on corrected addresses which may appear as "decreases" when compared to previous counts. Zip codes with fewer than 5 cases reported were omitted from the table.
