



## COVID-19 Epidemiology Report for DeKalb County March 3, 2021

- As of March 2, DeKalb County has reported 52,020 confirmed cases of 2019 novel coronavirus disease (COVID-19) and 784 confirmed COVID-19 deaths. An increase of 243 cases (+0.5%) and 11 deaths (+1.4%) since the last report on March 1.
- 1,536 COVID-19 cases (193 cases per 100,000 population) were diagnosed in the most recent 14-day period (2/11 – 2/24), a **41.6% DECREASE** from the previous 14-day period (1/28 – 2/10).
- Among all persons diagnosed with COVID-19 in DeKalb County, 8.0% needed hospitalization and 1.5% died.
- As of March 2, Georgia Department of Public Health reported that DeKalb County accounted for 6.3% of total number of COVID-19 cases in Georgia to date.
- As of March 2, Georgia Department of Public Health has reported a total of 121,651 COVID-19 vaccines (Dose 1: 74,469, Dose 2: 47, 182) have been administered so far in DeKalb County.












\*Data as of 3/2/2021. Only data on Polymerase Chain Reaction (PCR) tests were included. All data reported are preliminary and subject to change


## COVID-19 Related Deaths in DeKalb County and Georgia






### COVID-19 Related Deaths by Age, DeKalb County



