DUTIES: Under the Community Research Coordinator's general supervision in the Health Assessment and Promotion Department, the Public Health Educator will support the ongoing community-based participatory research (CBPR) efforts. These efforts include collaborating with community stakeholders to assist in research that effectively addresses health disparities under the Center for Urban Research, Development, Sustainability, and Evaluation (CURDSE) Initiative. CURDSE is a community-focused research collaboration that aims to develop evidence-based solutions that eliminate health disparities and achieve health equity for DeKalb County residents.

MINIMUM QUALIFICATIONS: Master's degree in Public Health Education from an accredited college or university **OR** Bachelor's degree in Education, Social, Behavioral or Biological Sciences or a directly related field from an accredited college or university **AND** One year of experience in public health education.
