Answers to each question posed is posted below in **blue**

1. *Can you tell me if these are actual x-rays captured on film that need to be picked up or couriered to the Radiologists or are they in a digital format and can be electronically sent to the Radiologists?*

**The images are in digital format, can be posted for the radiologist's access, and must be interpreted in accordance with the American College of Radiology (ACR) practice parameters and technical standards, including the use of a high-resolution monitor.**

**Occasionally we have film in analog format that will need to be compared to current digital film(s). All our images prior to our current digital format being set up are still in an analog format.**

2. *Also can you tell us what type of x-rays they will be and volume per day or month? What is the monthly or annual volume of x-rays received?*

**The images are primarily pediatric and adult chest radiographs.**

3200-3600 patients for fiscal year 2018-2019

3. *I am American Board of Radiology and radiologists certified but in the state of South Carolina. In order to apply for this bid, must I be certified in Georgia?*

**The current information online is not clear, so the applicant for the position would need to check with the Georgia Composite Medical Board. If Georgia does allow interpretation by a radiologist licensed in another state, I would suggest the clinic investigate whether Medicaid, Medicare, and various other insurance plans would reimburse for the X-ray interpretation and whether there may be an effect on litigation.**
