DUTIES: The Nurse Practitioner (NP) performs advanced nursing functions and provides comprehensive medical services in specialized areas. Operates under a written nurse protocol agreement with their delegating physician, conducts complete physicals, provides treatment, and counsels clients. Collaborates with the Medical Director and Health Assessment and Promotion (HAP) Manager in the management of patients, and coordinates referrals and follow-up care. May prescribe medication in some cases. Works closely with the Chronic Disease Prevention Coordinator and the Manager of Clinical Nursing Services to provide outreach and direct services to support the identification and control of prediabetes and Type 2 diabetes among Adult African American underserved or high-risk patients living in DeKalb County, GA. Responsible for implementing the Diabetes Nurse Protocol, management of patients, coordination of referrals, and follow-up care. Assists with the recruitment and referral into the Diabetes Prevention Program (DPP) and the Diabetes Self-Management Education Program (DSME).

MINIMUM QUALIFICATIONS: Doctorate or Master's degree in nursing from an accredited college or university and/or other education requirements approved by the Georgia Board of Nursing **AND** certification in the specialty area(s) approved by Georgia Board of Nursing **AND** Georgia license as a Registered Professional Nurse **AND** Georgia license as an APRN **AND** CPR certification.

PREFERRED QUALIFICATIONS: In addition to the minimum qualifications, preference will be given to applicants with experience in the Nurse Practitioner role and at least two years of demonstrated experience and expertise in diabetes education, working with persons with diabetes and their families on an outpatient and inpatient basis in both individual and group format. Exceptional skills in both verbal and written communication. Certified by the National Certification Board for Diabetes Educators (CDE) and the American Nurses Credentialing Center as an adult Nurse Practitioner.

If this position requires a college degree and you are selected for an interview, you will be required to submit official transcripts to the Human Resources Department prior to any official offer of employment.
