MINIMUM QUALIFICATIONS: Master's degree in Public Health Education from an accredited college or university **OR** Bachelor's degree in Education, Social, Behavioral or Biological Sciences or a directly related field from an accredited college or university **AND** One year of experience in public health education.

PREFERRED QUALIFICATIONS: In addition to the minimum qualifications, preference will be given to applicants with a strong knowledge of HIV/AIDS and a strong understanding of the National HIV Strategy. Also, must demonstrate the ability to present to large and/or small groups.
