SALARY INFORMATION: \$55.00 Per Hour/Pay Grade I

DUTIES: Under general supervision, provides professional nursing care with a PrEP concentration in accordance with established nurse protocols. Performs clinical assessment for PrEP eligibility, provides treatments, educate clients on sexual health problems, and provides the necessary referrals to internal and external health care providers. Assist with monthly PrEP awareness events, and administer PrEP/nPEP. Works in the program area of adult health (STD, Breast and Cervical Cancer Program, Family Planning), but may also work in the child health immunization/travel clinic and other duties as needed.

MINIMUM QUALIFICATIONS: Bachelor's degree in Nursing from an accredited college or university **AND** current Georgia license to practice as a Registered Professional Nurse **AND** CPR certification **OR** Associate's degree in nursing from an accredited college or university **AND** One year of nursing experience **AND** completion of a PHN course within one year of hire **AND** current Georgia Registered Professional Nurse license **AND** CPR certification.

PREFERRED QUALIFICATIONS: In addition to the minimum qualifications, preference will be given to applicants who have experience developing partnerships with medical providers, working with STD/PrEP eligibility and adherence protocols.

NOTE: Employment with the DeKalb County Board of Health is not complete or official until applicants meet all pre-employment requirements. If this position requires a college degree and you are selected for an interview, you will be required to submit official transcripts to the Human Resources Department prior to any official offer of employment.
